

DAY 1

Depart the USA. Begin your journey of purpose and faith as you depart for Israel the land where history and prophecy meet.

DAY 2

Arrival in Israel / Tel Aviv. Arrive in Tel Aviv and settle into your hotel. Depending on arrival time, enjoy a peaceful walk along the Mediterranean waterfront and visit the lively Carmel Market for fresh juice and local treats.

Dinner and overnight in Tel Aviv.

DAY 3

Jaffa / Caesarea / Nazareth / Sea of Galilee. Explore Jaffa Old City, the ancient port where Jonah fled and where Peter received his vision at the house of Simon the Tanner (Acts 10). Continue to Caesarea Maritima, where Paul stood before Roman governors, and see the theater, Hippodrome, and palace ruins. Journey north to Nazareth, overlooking the Jezreel Valley from Mount Precipice, and end the day with a night swim in the Sea of Galilee.

Dinner and overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4

Ministry Around the Sea of Galilee.

Follow the footsteps of Jesus' ministry around the Galilee. Visit Capernaum, the Church of the Multiplication, and the shore where Jesus restored Peter after the resurrection. Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and visit Korazin, an archaeological site including a synagogue. End the evening around a bonfire by the water, sharing fellowship and reflection. Dinner and overnight in Galilee.







DAY 5

Northern Israel: Borders and Faith.

Travel north to Israel's borders with Lebanon and Syria. Visit Banias (Caesarea Philippi) and its scenic waterfall, explore Tel Dan, and walk through the historic Mount Bental bunkers overlooking the Golan Heights. Time permitting, hike Gamla, the ancient city of the Zealots. Dinner and overnight in Galilee.

DAY 6

Beit She'an / Jordan River / Dead Sea.

Drive south to the impressive ruins of Beit She'an, one of the Decapolis cities where cultures once converged. Stop at the Jordan River near Jericho for a special time of reflection and renewal, then continue to the Dead Sea for an unforgettable floating experience. Dinner and overnight at the Dead Sea.

DAY 7

Masada / Ein Gedi / Qumran / Travel to Jerusalem.

Ascend the desert fortress of Masada, stand where Jewish rebels made their last stand, and descend for a refreshing hike through Ein Gedi, the oasis where David hid from Saul. Visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, and stop at a viewpoint overlooking St. George Monastery before arriving in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 8

Volunteer Day / TBN Studios / Jerusalem Old City.

Spend the morning participating in one of our meaningful volunteer projects, serving where help is most needed. Activities may include assisting farmers in southern Israel, supporting displaced families, or visiting and encouraging wounded soldiers at Shaare Zedek Medical Center. Volunteer projects are scheduled based on the most current needs in Israel, so the timing and locations may vary slightly from tour to tour. In the afternoon, visit TBN Studios and join Yair Pinto for a live podcast recording, hearing firsthand insights about faith, resilience, and Israel today. Later, explore Jerusalem's Old City walk the ancient walls, visit the markets, and explore the City of David, including Hezekiah's Tunnel.

Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.











DAY 9

Mount of Olives / Garden of Gethsemane / Garden Tomb.

Begin with communion at the Garden Tomb, a moving reminder of Christ's resurrection. Visit the Mount of Olives, walk the Palm Sunday Road, and stop in the Garden of Gethsemane. End the day with a farewell reflection overlooking Jerusalem a final moment to pray for the people you've served and the land you've walked. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 10

Departure. Transfer to the airport for your return flight carrying memories of the land and the joy of having served its people.

- Visiting families of hostages and displaced residents
