GREECE

DAY 1

Depart the United States for Athens.

Begin your spiritual adventure as you board your flight to Athens the city where Paul first brought the Gospel to Europe.

DAY 2

Arrival in Athens. Arrive in Greece and settle into your hotel. Take in your first glimpses of the city that gave birth to philosophy, art, and faith encounters that shaped Christian history.

Dinner and overnight in Athens.

DAY 3

Athens / Acropolis / Parthenon / Areopagus.

Stand on the Areopagus, where Paul boldly declared the message of Christ to the thinkers of his time. Explore the Acropolis, Parthenon, and Acropolis Museum timeless reminders of a civilization hungry for truth.

Dinner and overnight in Athens.



DAY 4

Corinth / Canal.

Journey to ancient Corinth, where Paul ministered for 18 months. See the Bema Seat and temple ruins, walk through the ancient marketplace, and pause for reflection at the Corinth Canal a marvel of engineering that connects the Aegean and Ionian Seas.

Dinner and overnight in Athens.

MALTA

DAY 5

Flight to Malta.

Fly to the island of Malta, where Paul was shipwrecked but found kindness among strangers. Sail through Valletta's Grand Harbor aboard a traditional dghajsa and see one of Europe's most picturesque skylines.

Dinner and overnight in Valletta.

DAY 6

St. Paul's Malta / St. Paul's Bay.

Discover the legacy of Paul's stay on Malta. Visit St. Paul's Church and Grotto, explore the medieval city of Mdina, and walk the narrow streets of Rabat, the "Silent City."

Dinner and overnight in Valletta.

DAY 7

Gozo Island.

Cross to Gozo Island and explore the Ġgantija Temples among the oldest structures in the world. Visit the Cathedral dedicated to Mary, Mother of Jesus, and enjoy Malta's serene countryside.

Dinner and overnight in Valletta.





SICILY

DAY 8

Flight to Sicily.

Fly to the beautiful island of Sicily, known for its rugged coastline and rich history. Visit the local Artists' Colony before continuing to Syracuse, where Paul spent time during his journey to Rome.

Dinner and overnight in Syracuse.

DAY 9

St. Paul's Sicily.

Explore Syracuse's ancient archaeological site the Roman Amphitheatre, Greek Theatre, and the Temple of Apollo. Feel history come alive as you stand where faith and empire once met.

Dinner and overnight in Syracuse.

DAY 10

Ortigia Island.

Walk through Ortigia Island's charming streets, visit the ancient Mikvah, the magnificent Cathedral, and the Apollo Temple. Enjoy free time for rest, reflection, or local exploration.

Dinner and overnight in Syracuse.

DAY 11

Agrigento.

Travel to Agrigento and discover the Valley of the Temples a breathtaking UNESCO site where ancient Greek architecture tells stories of faith and resilience.

Dinner and overnight in Palermo.

ITALY

DAY 12

Pompeii / Rome.

Fly from Palermo to Naples and step into history at Pompeii, a city frozen in time by volcanic ash. Journey along the Appian Way the same road Paul traveled to Rome.

Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 13

Paul's Rome.

Explore the Eternal City: the Colosseum, Roman Forum, and Mamertine Prison, where Paul and Peter were held for their faith. Imagine the courage that shaped the Church in the face of persecution.

Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 14

Vatican City / Basilica of St. Paul.

Visit the Vatican Museums, marvel at the Sistine Chapel, and stand in awe at St. Peter's Basilica. Conclude your pilgrimage at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls — the traditional burial site of the Apostle Paul.

Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 15

Return to the United States.

Depart from Rome filled with memories, inspiration, and a renewed connection to your faith.
